With the Start-up Amplifier, we aim to give top start-ups the opportunity to play a key role in EIT Health Innovation Projects.

If you are a start-up in the space of biotech, med-tech or digital health, and you would like to accelerate your product or service to market, the EIT Health Amplifier may be for you.

What we support with the EIT Health Start-up Amplifier:

- Collaborative projects between the start-up and members of the [EIT Health community](#). EIT Health includes top corporate partners, research organisations, universities, healthcare payers and providers, as well as cities and municipalities all over Europe.
- The ultimate objective of the projects should be rapid market penetration of innovative products and services, and/or the testing and implementation of novel organisational structures and healthcare delivery processes.
- Projects that last a maximum of three years.

Support we give:

- Access to a top quality health innovation network.
- Support with project implementation and preparation through facilitation teams in several European locations (see contacts below).
- Favourable legal collaboration framework, alignment with European Commission Horizon 2020 funding rules.
- Maximum of €3 million for the entire consortium, of which a maximum of €500 000 in funding is available for the start-up in a 3-year project and a cap of €250 000 per year. Partners are asked to contribute to the project. See details in our [Calls for Proposals](#).
- Projects selected through the current Calls for Proposals would start 1 January 2021.

What is the deal?

- The EIT Health Start-up Amplifier is a "grant for options" scheme. Based on validated and proven valuation, EIT Health assumes Options in the start-up based on funding awarded.
